Farming

The Foundations for Farming (FFF) project collaborates with schools, churches, and individuals to promote and educate on farming using God's Way principles.



Additionally, we operate a nursery where trees are cultivated for sale to the community, with proceeds funding various office projects. The main goal is to train individuals in tree cultivation techniques like growing, grafting, and budding to generate revenue. Presently, our nursery houses 168 citrus trees, with 26 trees successfully budded and displaying growth and progress, including 10 rough lemons, 2 grapefruits, 6 navel oranges, and 8 naartjies.







Initially involving 28 individuals and 2 churches, the program received 30 Hippo Rollers and farming tools as donations from Rotary. Due to the progress achieved, Rotary has generously pledged to donate an extra forty (40) Hippo Rollers. We are truly grateful for this opportunity and eagerly anticipate impacting more lives positively through this initiative.



AWANA

Currently the AWANA program has identified 17 new churches to be engaged in the yearly program that will offer the AWANA trainings coupled with the Human Trafficking awareness, World Lead trainings as well as the Farming foundations for community transformation. In the upcoming month we anticipate expanding the outreach efforts and continue empowering churches and schools. We will be engaging the new pastors to bring the program to more communities and reach more people through the gospel.

While at the port, teams from Logos Hope interact with communities, offering practical help and spreading a message of hope through the gospel in cooperation with local churches and partner organizations. The Logos Hope ship serves as a hub for unity and aid, uniting individuals from different countries.



On Logos Hope, the ministry is characterized by compelling stories shared by volunteers who encounter God's guidance and backing in areas where Christianity is not prevalent. The unwavering commitment of one volunteer led to a spiritual transformation within his family due to his dedication to spreading the Gospel. The THOASA team were moved by the devoted commitment of the ship's volunteers. These volunteers travel from their countries at their own expense, spreading the Gospel worldwide, including in areas with Muslim communities. Some receive financial aid from family members, while others adapt their education to grasp the languages used aboard the ship. Witnessing this dedication has motivated the THOASA team to continue their divine mission despite obstacles.
